Rental & Payment Information: Reservations are accepted beginning on March 1 each year. We are not permitted to hold dates. Availability is on a first-come first served basis. Please come to the recreation office Monday – Friday, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. to complete a reservation request and obtain a permit. It is best to make an appointment by calling ahead. **Full payment must be made at the time of your reservation.**

A money order is required as payment for your reservation. No cash, personal/business checks or credit cards are accepted. Please make the money order payable to: **Reisterstown Recreation Council**

Please Note: *Our pavilions do not have access to electricity or water.* The following rules apply to all rentals:

No alcoholic beverages, and no loud or amplified music, permitted on park grounds.

Person in charge of the group and/or the organization will be responsible for the actions and safety of the group and will comply with all rules.

No motorized vehicles or mini bikes.

Pets must be leashed. Owners must clean up after pets. No horses, ponies or livestock allowed in the park.

No moon bounces or inflatable play structures.

Charcoal grills are permitted, however, no gas grills are permitted.

Pavilion use is governed by reservation.

All individuals/groups using the pavilions are expected to collect their trash and restore the area to a clean condition. With only a limited number of trash receptacles, please bring your own trash bags.

No refunds will be issued. If necessary to change the date of an event, please contact the office as soon as possible.

The park attendant has final authority in any dispute regarding the interpretation of park rules and regulations or in any other matter that may arise that is not covered by the park rules and regulations.

The playing of softball is in designated areas only. The park attendant will be the final authority regarding use of athletic fields. No picnic group may use the athletic field for more than one hour if the fields are available.

Any violation of the rules and regulations shall result in revocation of the permit, and the group will be required to vacate the park. The group may also be subject to legal action.
