**Directions:** -Take I-695 (the Baltimore Beltway) west towards Towson/Pikesville. -Get off on exit 19. This is I-795 North (the Northwest Expressway) towards Reisterstown. -Go seven (7) miles to exit 7A Franklin Blvd East. Exit onto Franklin Blvd. Get into the left lane once on Franklin Blvd. -Go 0.4 miles to second traffic light. -Turn Left onto Reisterstown Rd. (Route 140 North). -Take Reisterstown Rd for 0.3 miles. -Turn Right at the second Traffic light. Hannah More Lane is to the Right and Caraway Rd. is to the left. There is a large sign that says: "Hannah More Center". -Follow the one way drive around to the right. The first entrance drive entrance on the left is an access circle in front of the building for pick up and drop off only. No parking is allowed on the access drive. -The main drive takes you to the parking lot which curves around to the left. You should see the "Reisterstown Senior Center" sign on the building. -You will also see a large bell in front of the building. Use the main entrance to the building to the left of the bell. Once inside the building, the entrance to the Senior Center is the first door to the right. Walk to the far end of the room. -You are at GCOM Reisterstown: Hannah More!
